Lockable Regulators

Metal Work recently introduced a range of regulators that can be locked with a small padlock.

Most existing lockable regulators use a common key which causes problems if they are lost (must source the replacement from the original supplier) or, because the key is not unique, keyholders have access to change any of the lockable regulators on site.

The regulators are supplied with a small padlock but this can easily be replaced by a locally sourced padlock so that as few or as many keys can be made available to your staff.

The lockable regulators are available across all three series of Metal Work service units.

Skillair - A range of compact, modular, high flow rate service units that can be removed/replaced without disturbing the pipework. The range includes diaphragm driers, coalescing filters, carbon activated filters, filters, regulators, progressive start valves, shut-off valves, lubricators, distributors, pilot operated regulators and proportional regulators. Manufactured using metal alloys and techno-polymers in sizes from 1/4" to 2".

BIT - A cost effective range of techno-polymer service units in

1/4". The range includes filters, regulators, lubricators and a mini coalescing filter.

New Deal - A rugged die-cast range of service units from 1/4" to 1/2". Heavy duty and can withstand inlet pressures up to 18bar. The range comprises coalescing filters, filters, regulators, progressive start valves, shut-off valves, lubricators, distributors, pilot operated regulators and proportional regulators.
