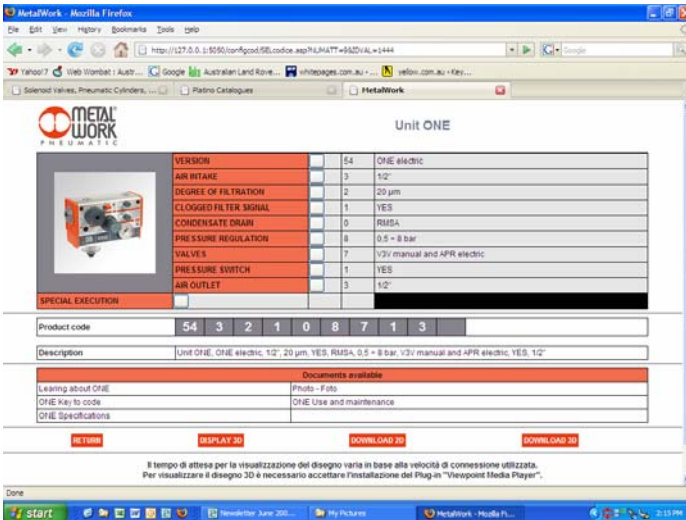


CD Catalogue

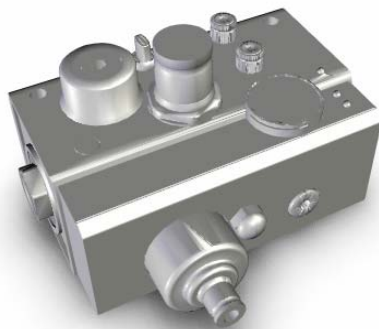
Metal Work have just released a new CD catalogue to help save you time when using pneumatic products into your machine designs.



Specify the part you require

Once the catalogue is installed on your PC with the CD in the drive, start the software, select 'E Catalogue' and then click on the English Flag in the top RH corner of the screen. From this screen you can then select the product range eg. Pneumatic Actuators, Valves, FRL Units, Fittings & Accessories etc. and then the product type and then finally specify any options required. You may have to enable 'popups' on your PC to allow the software to run. You should be able to just enable popups for the Metal Work software.

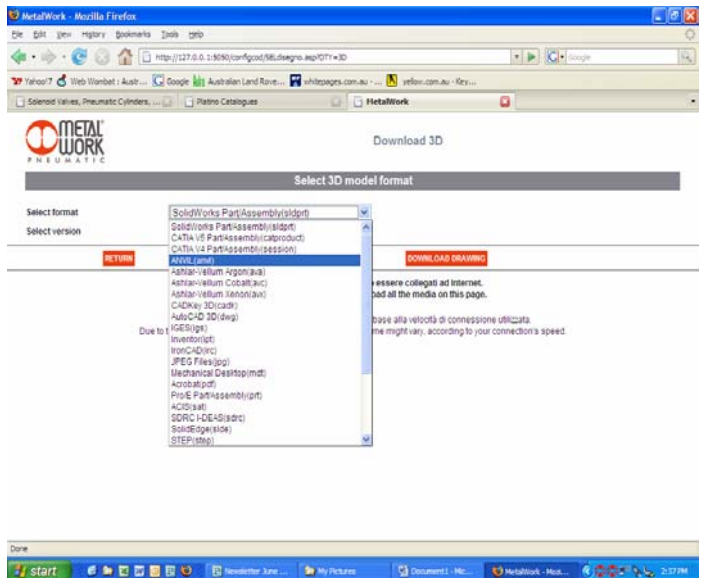
Once this is completed you will have the Metal Work part number plus you will also have access to technical data (.pdf files) and images plus you will be able to download 2D and 3D files for the product chosen or a 3D image (you may have to download software to allow you to view the 3d Image on your PC).

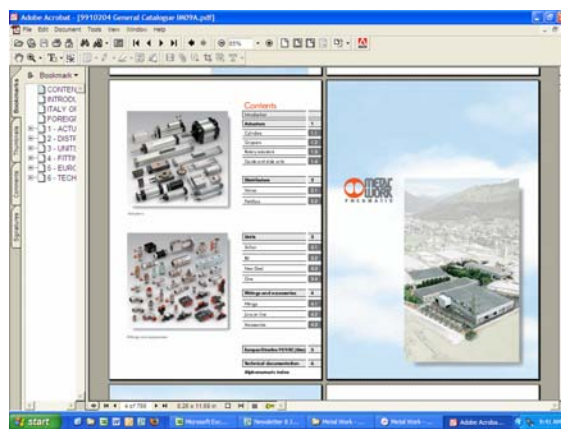
Select the file format you require
